

Cornerstone Chapel Bible School Course Descriptions

Courses Available – June 2021

The Heart of a Leader.....June 2021

This course deals with the specifics of the preparation of the heart for leadership in ministry. A greater understanding of the requirements to make ready for a special purpose, to make suitable, to fit, to adapt, to train, to equip or to furnish. This course explores the scriptural dynamics of the heart that God is looking for and requires to be able to endure through all the seasons and requirements of ministry and leadership.

Courses Available September 2021 - June 2022

Destiny in Ministry.....September 2021

Throughout this course, you will be presented with the invaluable truths and principles of God's divine destiny as it is outlined in the Scriptures. By examining the lives and stories of such Biblical examples as Joseph, King David, and Jesus and His disciples, the elements of one's personal destiny will be made more and more evident through the understanding of God's divine process toward destiny.

Romans.....October 2021

This course is designed to explore and discuss the major themes found in the book of Romans. This class will focus on understanding, defining and practically applying each of the following: God's general revelation, salvation, justification by faith, the reason for the law and the doctrine of sin, God's view of Israel and practical godly living.

Hermeneutics.....November 2021

This course is designed to introduce the student to the principles and rules to use to interpret the scriptures accurately. It will survey types and shadows, predictive prophecy, symbols, parables and other parts of scripture with tools to interpret correctly. This course is imperative for all those who love to study the word of God, plan on preaching or teaching God's Word and are preparing for ministry.

Old Testament I.....November 30 - December 2021

Providing an overview of The Old Testament from Genesis to II Kings, Old Testament Survey I gives the student a solid overview of the Old Testament. The perusal through each book presents the author, message, theme and spiritual emphasis revealing the intertwining thread of redemption to mankind. The insights offered in this course will inspire the student toward a more in-depth search of the Old Testament Scriptures.

Old Testament II.....January 2022

This course is a continuation of Part I and presents a survey of the remaining Old Testament books. The splitting of the Kingdom ushered in a new methodology of God's interaction with His people, that of the prophetic message. The power of a covenant keeping God provides the platform from which this study blossoms. The unveiling of the heart of God revealed through a study of the major and Minor Prophets will motivate the student to seek a life-changing personal spiritual renewal.

Church History.....February 2022

The purpose of this course is to help students become familiar with the periods of church history. Students will explore important leaders, significant issues and events, great movements and the characteristics of the True church.

Evangelism.....March 2022

This course will teach you the nuts and bolts of putting hands and feet to your faith concerning fulfilling the Great Commission. As students actively engage their hearts in this class, the words of Jesus in Jn. 20:21b "as the Father sent me so send I you" will become a life altering reality as you learn to DO the work of the ministry in winning souls for Christ

Doctrine of the Holy Spirit II.....March 29 - April 2022

This course identifies the Holy Spirit's role and manifestation in the life of the believer according to the scripture. A full exploration of the nine spiritual gifts and their relevance, function and power is fully explored.

Authority of the Believer.....May 2022

This class will address the following questions: Does the church today have authority or was it only for the early church? Is the power and authority for only a select few handpicked men and women of God in the Body of Christ? Is everything that happens in the Church and the world the will of God? Students will come face to face with the answers to these questions and more, as well as learning how to effectively do the works of Jesus today just like the New Testament saints accomplished in the book of Acts.

Spirit Lead Leadership.....May 31 thru June 2022

This course is designed to teach students how to be a strong leader that develops those under their leadership while developing their ability to be led by the Holy Spirit.

Courses Completed for this term, but will be available again starting September 2022

Knowing God.....Available fall of 2022

The starting place in any ministry endeavor is to have a strong and intimate relationship with God. This course brings the learner to a new level of understanding regarding who God is and what His desire is relationally with His people. Included in this class is a detailed examination of absolute and moral attributes of God. The culture of today is permeated with the falsehood of "other gods". Knowing God reveals the one true and Living God for who He is and what He does in the heart of man.

Principles of Faith.....Available fall of 2022

This course takes a different route to faith. It will serve to establish our identity through Christ rather than the negative emotions that drive us and separate us from God's divine destiny for our lives. Our understanding of our identity determines whether we can be an over comer and not live our lives as casualties.

God's Healing Power.....Available fall of 2022

Through a thorough Biblical study of divine healing the student can fully understand the attitude of God toward sickness. This course is designed to erase all doubt you may have had regarding God's Will and intention to heal ALL. This course will provide an understanding of the ministry of healing provided in the

atonement of Jesus Christ. The student will be able to know and plainly speak out that God took both our sins and our sickness and placed them on our Lord Jesus, by whose stripes we are healed. From cover to cover, the Bible provides undeniable evidence that it is God's will to heal the sick and we are commissioned to minister this truth to others.

New Testament Survey I.....Available 2023

This course is an historical and thematic survey of the contents of the four Gospels and the Book of Acts. Particular attention is given to the cultural, historical and geographical settings for the preparation, entrance, and ministry of our Savior, Jesus Christ. The impact of the Gospel in New Testament times is juxtaposed with today's culture and generation to give the student a platform of application of the timeless truths that New Testament literature presents.

New Testament Survey II.....Available 2023

This course is a continuation of New Testament I and offers a historical and thematic survey of the contents of the New Testament from Acts to Revelation. Particular attention is given to the cultural, historical and geographical settings for each book. Special focus is given to the impact of the message of Kingdom living that the epistles present, not only to the Greco-Roman world but in our day as well.

Doctrine of the Holy Spirit I.....Available 2023

A thorough study of the Pentecostal doctrine of the Holy Spirit giving attention to the person and work of the Holy Spirit. This course focuses on knowing and experiencing the Holy Spirit's presence and empowerment in the Christian life. Offering a practical guide to the operation of the Holy Spirit, Doctrine of the Holy Spirit I presents the correlation of the gifting and fruit of the Holy Spirit.

Genesis: Journey of the Patriarchs.....Available 2023

Genesis means "origin, birth, and beginning. This class reveals through the creation story and the lives of the patriarchs how all truth begins with God and continues throughout the passage of time. No statement has ever been truer than..." In the beginning God."
