Choose questions for your small group.

1. What's one thing you learned from the message today? What made that stick out to you?
2. Have you ever heard the story of David and Goliath before? What's something new you learned about it today?
3. What are some issues in your life that feel like giants—things you feel powerless against?
4. David was confident in God because he had seen God help him before. What are some times God has helped you overcome something that felt giant at the time? Does that give you confidence to face the giants in your life now? Why or why not?
5. Read **Psalm 20:7 NIV**. If you're honest—would you say you have confidence in God's strength? What makes you say that?
6. What will you do to start facing some of the giants in your life? How can we help you do that?
7. What are some ways you can start trusting God to help you get through life's battles?
8. Take prayer requests and pray together.
